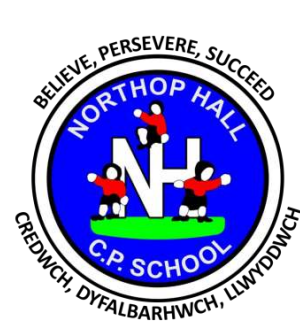


Welcome to Year 6

We will also be encouraging children to take further responsibility for themselves:

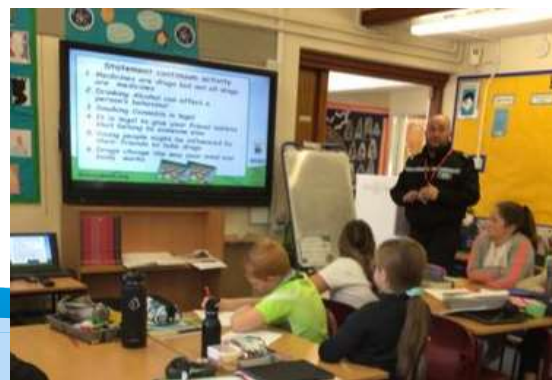
- Home time
