We will also be encouraging children to take further responsibility for themselves:

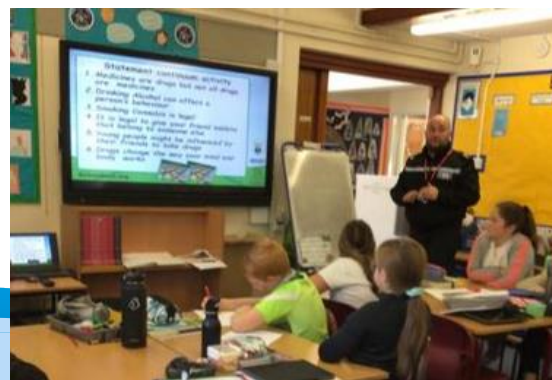
- Home time

- **Make sure you receive an e-mail to confirm your application has been submitted. If you do not receive a confirmation e-mail, please re-submit.**
- **Give careful consideration to your preferences**
- **Put down more than one school**

- **Prepare your child that they may not get their first choice of school**
- **Parents will be informed on 3rd March 2025– no details will be shared before this date**
- **Late applications are dealt with after those applications made on time.**
